Year Two countdown to leaving Cumberland Infants

Year Two leaving Cumberland is always the sad part of the end of the summer term. I know the children and staff have been working very hard to put together a recorded Leavers Assembly which I know I am really looking forward to watching on the screen. You will have an opportunity to watch their Leavers Assembly in the comfort of your own home.

On Monday 19th July, just Year Two children should bring some of their own clothes in a named bag to change into at end of the day. Year Two will stay at school until
